

Rotary Club of Duluth Foundation Scholarship Application Instructions

Rotary Club of Duluth Foundation Scholarships are awarded to Duluth, Superior, Hermantown and Proctor students during their successful first, second, third or fourth semester of Community/Technical College even if their course of approved study is only one semester long. Approved fields of study are in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) some examples are: aircraft pilot/maintenance; computer engineering /science/information systems/GIS, technician; construction trades – carpentry, electrical, masonry, plumbing, welding; construction equipment operation/maintenance; medical – nursing, technicians, therapists – occupational, physical, speech; public safety – police, fire; transportation – truck driving, maintenance; these are examples and do not represent all eligible technical fields. Applications are to be submitted o the Rotary Club of Duluth Foundation scholarship committee per the schedule in instruction 10 below. All information submitted will be held in confidence for the purpose of scholarship administration. Scholarships will be presented to the student's school of choice to be used for tuition or other educational endeavors. Scholarship awards may be up to \$1,250.00 per semester, depending on need.

- 1. This is a writable PDF. You will be able to save your work and edit your responses if you use Adobe Acrobat; otherwise you must print the application after you have completed it. You may also print the application and fill it out by hand. Make sure your handwriting is legible.
- Please attach your SAR (Student Aid Report) and Financial Award Letter from the school you are attending; Lack of data may result in elimination from Rotary Club of Duluth Foundation Scholarship consideration.
- 3. Attach a transcript of your courses.
- 4. Complete all information. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
- 5. Page 4, print or type an essay and include with your application. The essay must be original thoughts on how your technical education will assist you in your career, aspirations and goals in life.
- Page 5, provide a letter or recommendation from a person who knows you (teacher, counselor, employer, pastor, etc.) not a family member, who can attest to your character and capability for completing your course of study.
- 7. Finalist candidates must be present for a personal interview with the scholarship committee. Each finalist candidate is requested to file a FAFSA (Federal Aid Form Student Application) and if you are selected to receive a Rotary Club Scholarship bring or send a copy of the SAR that you will get from the federal government once you have filed your FAFSA.
- 8. Successful applicants will be invited to attend a Rotary Club lunch meeting where they will be introduced to the Club by a member of the Scholarship committee and given an opportunity to present their career plans and how the Scholarship helped, to the Club membership present.
- 9. Scholarships will be awarded to nontraditional students and scholarship applicants from disadvantaged backgrounds.
